

### Help with Literacy

Support with practicing the words and sounds on the home learning sheet in the Little Wandle folder. Share reading book and talk about the story. Practice name writing and refine pencil grip.

### Physical Development

Learning to control movement through travelling techniques. Use different equipment to develop circuits to travel around safely assessing risks. Learning about our bodies and how we grow.

### Mathematics

Learning about the quantity and value of numbers to 3. Looking at numbers in the environment. Learning about how numbers can be partitioned and built. Beginning to recognise what numbers to 3 look like as a quantity. Counting to 10 and beyond.

### Communication and Language

Listening and responding to others, developing attention and increasingly detailed responses. Developing imagination through role play, through familiar experiences and links to favourite stories.

### Literacy

Focus on pencil control and name writing. Using the stories *The Colour Monster*, *Marvelous Me*, and *Super Duper You* to encourage talk about ourselves. Beginning to give meanings to our marks.

### Expressive arts and design

Creating images of self in paint, pencil and on the computer. Learning to sing familiar songs and learn to listen to and respond to music through dance.

### Help with Maths

Practice ordering number cards and recognising the numerals out of order. Practice counting out objects from a bigger group, focusing on counting accurately to 3.

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Settling into a new environment. Recognising and dealing with feelings and facing new challenges. Learning about what makes a friend and learn to work and play together.

### Understanding the world

Learning about our local environment, the school and locality. Understanding the changes that occur in Autumn. Learning about some of the people in our community that help us.
