



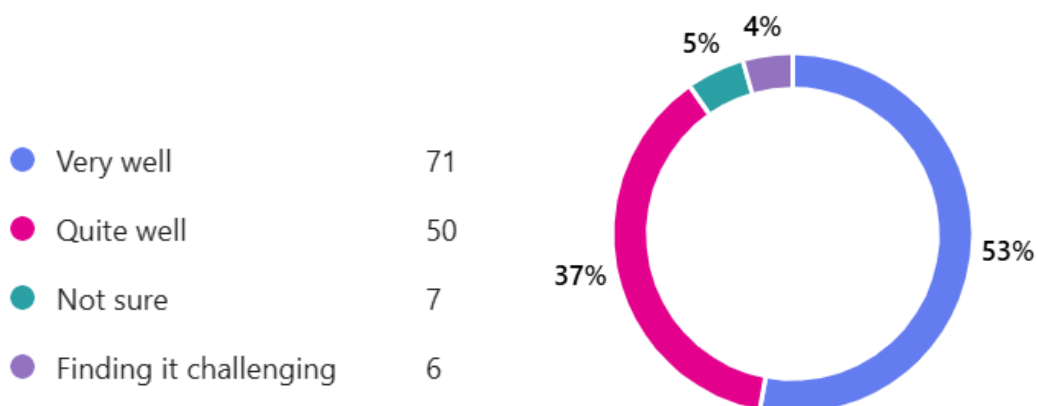
### Parental Feedback

### Remembrance Day

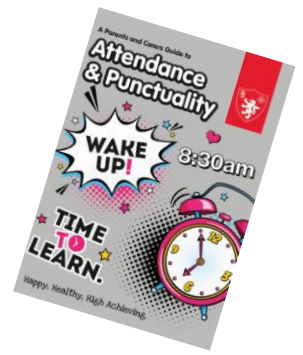

## Attendance Matters



At Brownlow, we monitor pupil attendance regularly to ensure every child is making the most of their learning opportunities. Over the next two weeks, we will be looking at attendance data in more detail. Please remember that it is a legal requirement for your child to attend school every day, unless they are unwell or have an authorised reason for absence.

If your child's attendance falls below 90%, this is classed as persistent absence, and you will receive a letter from school to discuss how we can work together to improve attendance.

Good attendance is key to your child's progress, wellbeing, and enjoyment of school life — thank you for your continued support in helping us achieve this.
